Fact Sheet

The Torres Strait Licence Register lists all Torres Strait licence holders including Traditional Inhabitant Boat (TIB) licences, Transferrable Vessel Holder (TVH) licences, Sunset licences, Master Fisherman's licences, Carrier licences, Carrier-Processor licences and Fish Receivers licences.

The register also includes how many quota units are held by TVH licence holders in the TRL Fishery, how many kilograms of Spanish mackerel, coral trout and other reef line species are leased to Sunset licence holders in the Finfish Fishery, and which fishery entries each licence is authorised for:

BD Beche-de-mer

CB Crab

CR Tropical rock lobster

LN Reef line

MK Spanish mackerel

Ы Pearl shell

TR **Trochus**

The register allows fish receivers to check that they are receiving fish from licenced fishers, prior to completing a Catch Disposal Record. It allows fishers wanting to unload their catch to know who has a Fish Receiver licence.
