Dear Torres Strait Beche-de-mer Fishery Traditional Inhabitant Boat (TIB) Licence Holder,

Notification of determination of 3 May 2021 as the TAC Date for black teatfish fishery

I am writing to inform you that, as the PZJA Delegate, I have determined the **TAC Date** for black teatfish to be 3 May 2021 based on my reasonable belief that the TAC will be reached on or about that date whilst avoiding the risk of an overcatch.

This means you are not permitted to fish for black teatfish after 3 May 2021. This is one of the conditions of your licence as varied on 26 February 2021.

As at 10.55 pm on 3 May, a total of 16.59 tonnes of black teatfish has been reported as being caught. Having considered reported catches since the commencement of the black teatfish opening on 30 April, I have determined the **TAC Date** in accordance with conditions of your licence, which I issued to all licence holders on 26 February 2021.

Please be aware that fish receivers will not be permitted to receive black teatfish after the **TAC Date**, which I have determined to be 3 May 2021.
